## *A Note From the Administrators*

*This school year continues to move quickly by and interims will be issued February 7. Please look over your child's grades carefully and discuss with your child how they are doing with working towards their goal. If you have a concern please notify the teacher. Each teacher has a planning period each day and can meet with you during this time.*

*Please ask your child if they need to replenish their supplies, especially Kleenex. Remind your child to wash their hands frequently as we are still battling a large number of students with the flu.*

*We have seen an increase in the number of students who are coming out of uniform. Please check your child's uniform to ensure that everything is in accordance with our uniform policy.*

The official uniform for C.T. Janet Elementary students consist of the following:

- **Top:** Navy blue school shirt (may be t-shirt, golf shirt, blouse, or sweatshirt) with school emblem embroidered or silk screened. PK students only wear the purple t-shirt or golf shirt with school emblem. All undershirts must be white. All shirts must be tucked in at all times.
- **Bottom:** Solid navy blue skirt, jumper, pants, shorts, or skorts must be worn. Restrictions: Bottoms may not have flare legs, no leggings, no warm-up/ pants, no cargo pants. Solid navy blue sweat pants may be worn on cold days only. Bottoms must be worn on the waist—no undergarments should be seen. All bottoms should be properly hemmed, not rolled or frayed at the bottom.
- **Belts:** Required for grades 2-5. Solid black, navy blue, or brown belts only. Belts should not have buckles larger than 1.5 inches, rhinestones, sequins, or other flashy items.
- **Shoes and Socks:** Tennis shoes only that come no higher than the ankle. Any color tennis shoe is acceptable. No heelys, with or without wheels. No sandals, open toe, or open back shoes are allowed. Socks, tights, and stockings must be solid white.
- **Outerwear:** Any sweater or sweatshirt worn inside the building must be solid navy blue, with or without the school logo. No other logo should be visible.
- **Overcoats:** Any coat or jacket worn outside may be any color or style.
