A Note From the Administrators

Spring Testing is now upon us. Fifth grade students will begin LEAP 2025, computer based testing this month. It is so important that our students come to school each and every day and that they are on time. The students have been well prepared and are ready to show what they know. Math will be tested on April 10-12, ELA will be tested April 16-18, SS will be tested April 20-24, and Science will be tested April 25-26. Fourth graders will also be taking their Science portion on the computer, those dates are April 13 & April 19. Please talk with your student about the importance of them taking their time and doing their absolute best.








During testing, **STUDENTS SHOULD NOT BRING CELL PHONES, SMART WATCHES OR ANY OTHER ELECTRONIC DEVICES**, as these do interfere with on line testing. Please do not schedule doctor's appointments during our testing days. We must adhere to a strict time schedule to make sure that students have adequate time to take the tests.

Third and Fourth Graders will continue their testing during the dates of April 30- May 4.





How to Tame

THE TEST MONSTERS

1. Wear layers of clothing to stay comfortable. 
2. Get enough sleep—about 10-11 hours a night. 
3. Do not eat sugary foods before a test. It will make you feel more tired and your brain will not work as fast. 
4. Breathe in through your nose to cool down and focus. 
5. Stay in the high + or low + emotion zones. 
6. Look up and left when trying to remember notes. 
7. Speak in an accent or sing when studying.

9. Take breaks. Attention is usually your age + 2.
12 years old + 2 = 14 minute attention
11 years old + 2 = 13 minute attention
10 years old + 2 = 12 minute attention
9 years old + 2 = 11 minute attention
8 years old + 2 = 10 minute attention

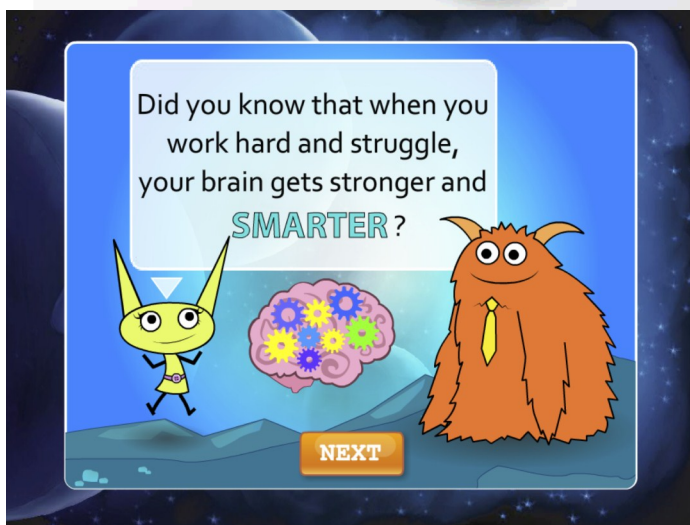
